Remind your MP and Senators If this legislation is passed - it will provide the freedom to legally insult people with what will be called a "statement of belief" which in reality, is a privilege that will legally override all anti discrimination legislation in this country.

Qld at the moment has strong anti hate speech laws, but they will offer very little protection and quickly become worthless.

Tell your MP - A Senate Inquiry is needed to ensure transparency of the government and those speaking need independence with a transparent process, because this proposed legislation is the most discriminatory legislation ever tabled

This legislation will provide privilege to a few - and ensure many become second class

This legislation will put many back into the closet and increase mental health issues

This legislation weakens anti discrimination laws in all States and Inclusion policies in the workplace - and we need to keep reminding politicians we are a secular nation and should remain so

Most true Christians do not support this proposed Bill I say its people of religion who do.

When talking to your MP you need to let it be known you don't want trade-offs with this legislation, you don't want deals done. You don't want to be a little bit equal.

You want equality. You pay your taxes and you contribute to society the same as everyone else in this country.

I suggest you contact Labor politicians and ask what they are doing to squash this? Because, I can tell you - presently they are doing very little so let it be known if they want your vote - do something otherwise Labor will spend a lot of time in the wilderness - if they don't
